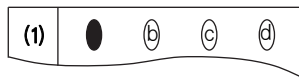
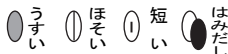

People are often grouped as either coffee people or tea people. And, while this is not a very serious category for dividing people, these two drinks are very popular in cultures all over the world.

Coffee and tea have very different histories, but both drinks spread to places very far from their homelands. Also, both coffee and tea were discovered (2) by chance and valued for having caffeine.

Tea comes from China and has a very long history, maybe starting almost 5000 years ago. Stories say that the Emperor Shennong discovered tea when the wind blew some leaves into his boiling water. He saw that the water changed color and had a nice smell. He drank it and found he had a special energy.

For a long time in China, people drank tea as a medicine because it could keep them awake and make them feel active when they were tired.

Tea spread (3) throughout China and then to other cultures in Asia. It came to Japan around 1500 years ago when Buddhist monks brought it from China. Tea spread from China to western cultures when Portuguese priests and merchants brought it to Europe in the 1500s.

Compared to tea, coffee is a younger drink. Its history began before the 1400s, in Ethiopia, which is part of North Africa. Stories say that the man who discovered coffee was named Kaldi. He saw that his goats became very (4) energetic and did not want to sleep after they ate beans from a tree. People made a drink using the beans and discovered that it gave them energy and made them less tired. From Ethiopia, coffee spread to Arabia. The drink spread to Europe and then to America in the 1600s. Coffee was first brought to Japan by Portuguese traders in the 1700s, but became popular in the 20<sup>th</sup> century.

Both drinks are loved by people around the world because they taste good, but also because they contain caffeine. Caffeine is a chemical that tastes bitter and stimulates the body's central nervous system. Caffeine makes people feel more (5) alert, but it is slightly addictive. While it is a drug, it is used in many different foods and drinks, not only tea and coffee.
